- 1. I, for myself, and on behalf of my heirs, assigned, personal representatives and next of kin, hereby release and hold harmless Parks & Rec. Woodshop, Inc., their officiers, officials, agents, volunteers and/or employees and other participants, sponsoring agencies, and if applicable, owners of the premises used to conduct the event or day to day business with respect to any and all injury, disability, death, or loss or damage to person or property, whether arising from the negligence of the released or otherwise.
- 2. I acknowledge that if I willfully or otherwise disregard safety rules, regulations, and precautions, posted, written, or implied, I am subject to either suspension, or expulsion from the Woodshop at the discretion of Parks & Rec. Woodshop, Inc. Board of Directors.
- 3. The risk of injury from activities involved in this program is significant including potential for permanent maiming and death. While particular rules, equipment and personal discipline may reduce risk, the risk of serious injury always exists.
- 4. I knowingly and freely assume all such risks, both known and unknown, even if arising from the negligence of others, and assume full responsibility for my participation.
- 5. I willingly agree to comply with the stated and customary terms and conditions for participation in the Woodshop. If, however, I observe any hazard endangering my presence or participation, I will remove myself from the situation and bring information about such hazards to the immediate attention of the Woodshop foreman.
- 6. I understand Parks & Rec. Woodshop, Inc. is not responsible for personal tools or other personal items brought into the Woodshop.
- 7. I agree that under no circumstances will tools contained within the Woodshop belonging to Parks & Rec. Woodshop, Inc. leave the premises at any time.
- 8. I agree to pay for repairs or replacement of any Woodshop tool/machine that is damaged or broken caused by negligence while in my use.
- 9. The days and hours the woodshop operates are based upon volunteers freely giving of their time. When and if a volunteer is not available to operate the Woodshop, it will be closed until alternate arrangements can be made.

Woodshop & Safety Rules

- 1. I agree to pay for repairs or replacement of any tool or machine that is broken in the Woodshop caused by my negligence or misuse.
- 2. Cleanup the area you were working in prior to leaving.
- 3. The use of the Woodshop, tools, and machines are for member projects only. The use of the Woodshop, tools, and machines for COMMERCIAL USE is strictly prohibited.
- 4. Do not use any power equipment or work in the Woodshop unless a Foreman is present. NO EXCEPTIONS!!
- 5. Do not operate any power equipment unless you have been instructed on its use by the Foreman.
- 6. Wear safety glasses at all times while you are in the Woodshop. Even if you are not working, safety glasses must still be worn.
- 7. Remove watches, rings, and all loose jewelry when working with power equipment.
- 8. Loose fitting clothing must be removed when working with any power equipment.
- 9. Always make sure that the blade and machine guards are in place and in working order.
- 10.Never change the settings on any piece of equipment when it is running. Always STOP the machine to make any adjustments.
- 11. Never freehand cut on the Table Saw. The miter gauge or rip fence must always be used.
- 12. Never operate any equipment while either under the influence of any drugs or alcohol, tired, or in any way feeling sick or under the weather.
- 13. If the operation you are about to do on any equipment does not feel safe, STOP, and get help from the Foreman.
- 14. Know where the safety shut-off switch is located on all equipment, as well as how to operate the switch in case of an emergency.
- 15. When cutting on the Table Saw, never stand directly in back of the blade in case of kickback.
- 16. Only <u>Foremen</u> can change cutting/milling blades on the machines. The only exception to this rule is the Router Table.
